## Uitwisseling 2016

In 1967 ontmoetten de burgemeesters J.M. Ravesloot van Delft en Z. Geller van Kfar Saba elkaar tijdens een Internationaal congres in Jeruzalem. Er ontstaat een vriendschappelijk contact. Na de 6 daagse oorlog (juni 1967) vraagt Delft aan Kfar Saba welke hulp men nodig heeft. Het antwoord luidt **dat vriendschap belangrijker is dan hulp**. Dan ontstaat het idee van een band tussen zustersteden, later partnersteden genoemd.

In oktober 1968 vond de eerste uitwisseling plaats. Door de vriendschappen tussen inwoners van beide steden en de belangstelling voor bezoeken is de band steeds sterker geworden. Delft is dertien keer in Kfar Saba geweest en Kfar Saba is ook dertien keer in Delft geweest. We gaan nu op naar de 14<sup>e</sup> uitwisseling.

## De overeenkomst

Op 26 oktober 1971 vond in Kfar Saba de officiële ondertekening plaats door de toenmalig waarnemend burgemeester en wethouder van Delft, de heer Nic. Hesseler en de burgemeester van Kfar Saba, de heer Zeev Geller.

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**Kinderdijk Cruise**

*From Rotterdam to Kinderdijk and back on the excursion boat Nehalennia*

**Kinderdijk**, a village near Rotterdam, is home to the largest collection of windmills in the Netherlands. Nineteen windmills--mostly from the mid-1700s--stand in neat rows along an L-shaped drainage canal, where they pumped water from the surrounding polders (areas of land below sea level that are protected by dikes) until steam and electric pumps offered more reliable protection against flooding.



Since 1997, Kinderdijk has been on UNESCO's World Heritage List, and the windmills in their park-like setting are one of South Holland's most popular tourist attractions.

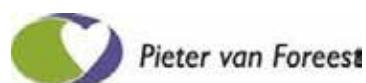

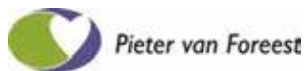

The Out-of-Hours Facility is located in a separate building next to the B-complex of the Reinier de Graaf Hospital and next to the entrance of the accident and emergency care of the hospital.

**When to call us?**

In case of emergency, when you have a serious health concern or when you have a medical problem that cannot wait until the next day, we are here for you for advice or if you want to make an appointment to talk to a general practitioner you can call us at: (015) 2511930. When you get an appointment at the Out-of Hours Facility, it is important you can identify yourself. We request you to bring a valid ID and if possible your insurance documents.

**We provide service in case of:**

Emergency and acute health problems during out of hours, when your regular practice is closed and your health problem needs to be seen right away and cannot wait until the next day:

- Acute disturbing illness,
- Sudden severe pain,
- High fever (in your child)
- Aggravating symptoms when seriously ill
- Prescriptions for medication you need to take immediately
- Telephone consultation about your health problem,
- Referral to the hospital.

**We don't provide service in case of:**

Health problems for which you go to your own general practitioner the next day:

- Unpleasant but not severe illness,
- Persistent symptoms you have been suffering from a longer period of time,
- If you don't have the time to visit your own general practitioner,
- Repeat prescriptions for non urgent medication
- For a second opinion
- General medical questions not relating to you being ill at the moment.

**Opening Hours:**

In the evening and at night from: 17:00 hr pm until 08:00 hr am  
During the weekends (24 hrs a day)  
During special holidays (24 hrs a day).



When can I call 112?

The emergency number 112 is for when you need urgent help, for instance when your life is in immediate danger, or if someone is seriously injured and needs prompt medical attention, or if you have witnessed a serious crime like assault, murder, robbery or a break-in.

Which service do you require?

When you call 112, please tell the operator:

what has happened;

what assistance is needed;

and what type of emergency service you think is required: the police, the fire brigade or the ambulance service.

The emergency operator will put you straight through to the appropriate emergency service in your area.

In an emergency, call 112

When should you call 112? Here are some examples:

You've had a car accident. No one has been injured, but you and your vehicle are a hazard

Because the situation is potentially life-threatening, call 112.

You see someone breaking into a car

You are the witness to a crime. You should call 112.

Someone is threatening you, in a public place or in your home

You are facing an immediate threat. Call 112, or ask a bystander to do so.

Someone is trying to break down your front door

You are facing an immediate threat. Call 112.

Your neighbours are having a terrible row. It sounds as if someone is being beaten up

This is a potentially life-threatening situation. Call 112.

***When there's no emergency, but you still need help***

If you need help, but not urgently, you can call the police using the national number 0900 8844 (local rates apply). The number of the nearest fire brigade can be found on their website.

Here are some examples of non-urgent situations.

You have had an accident, but the car is only dented

This is not a life-threatening situation.

You come home to find that your house has been burgled. The culprits are gone. Because the culprits are not there, the situation is not urgent. To report the crime, call the police on 0900 8844.

You find an animal stuck somewhere and unable to free itself

The fire brigade may come, but this is not an emergency. Call your local fire brigade.

You have no power, and the blackout appears to extend to the entire street. Call your electricity company.
